Background

Ingleburn Further Processing Plant currently holds an Environmental Protection License (EPL -licence number 11525). The Licence is regulated by the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) and the facility is required under Part 5.7A of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (POEO Act) to prepare, keep, test and implement a Pollution Incident Response Management Plan (PIRMP).

The PIRMP is only required for those incidents causing or threatening to result in material environmental harm (a material harm incident) as defined in the POEO Act.

The facility has prepared a PIRMP and a copy is kept, reviewed and tested at the facility. Some of the details included in the PIRMP are described below:
